FIDERH Student Loan:

The Fund for the Development of Human Resources (FIDERH) is a federal trust, administered by the Bank of Mexico, whose objective is to finance postgraduate studies for Mexican students. FIDERH Loan is for Mexican students and it is characterized by flexible long-term financing conditions, offering students the opportunity to repay the loan after completing their professional studies. This program was designed for graduate-level students, allowing them to cover up to \$300,000 pesos yearly to study in a National University and up to \$400,000 to study in an International University. Refund policy.

A student enrolled at CETYS University may initiate a withdrawal voluntarily, may be withdrawn due to non-compliance with academic or institutional regulations, or may be withdrawn for reasons not attributable to the student. All withdrawals produce academic and financial consequences and must follow institutional procedures to determinate if the student have a credit in favor because the earn service is less than the payments were made by the student. This not earned service must be refund to the student.

Institutional refunds are calculated using the earned service methodology. Tuition and fees are considered earned from the official start of the academic period until the student's last date of attendance. Charges are retained proportionally according to the portion of the academic period completed by the student.

The proportional calculation applies to tuition, international fees, insurance, transportation services, parking, and other services tied to time-based use. Non-time-based charges may be retained in full where services have already been provided.

The institutional refund calculation determines the balance owed to or from the student and is independent from any federal student aid calculation. Institutional refund amounts do not determine the amount of federal aid earned by the student.

Depending on the academic period in which the student is enrolled, this policy may vary according to the effective days of the course, which may include Ordinary or Intensive periods, Extraordinary periods, International periods, among others.

Withdrawal procedures.

Students withdrawals may be temporary or permanent, and may involve total separation from the institution or reduction of the academic load. Withdrawals may also be classified according to how they are initiated.

An official withdrawal occurs when the student submits written notification to the Registrar's Office. An unofficial withdrawal occurs when a student ceases attendance without providing formal notification, in which case the institution determines the withdrawal based on attendance documentation. The institution may also perform an administrative withdrawal due to academic dismissal, disciplinary action, or failure to maintain attendance requirements.

To process a withdrawal, the student must notify their intention to withdraw in writing or provide the necessary evidence to proceed with the withdrawal. For this purpose, the student must submit a Withdrawal Form to the Registrar's Office, indicating the conditions of the withdrawal and the information required to determine the implications of this process. This form is provided by the Academic or Psychopedagogical area corresponding to the student's academic level, following an interview. Please refer to the Appendix for the elements to be included in the Withdrawal Form.

All withdrawals have academic and financial implications. The academic status must be determined first, followed by the financial resolution. The latter is calculated based on the earned service as of the date on which there is evidence of the student's last attendance. For this purpose, the EARNED SERVICE CALCULATION POLICY described below shall be applied. For programs that do not have an enrollment fee, the earned service must be retained, with a minimum equivalent to 15% of tuition.

Return of funds requirements.

The institutional refund calculation determines the balance owed to or from the student and operates independently from any federal student aid calculation. If the funds have already been requested from the Federal Student Aid programs and the student requests withdrawal before 60% of the academic period has elapsed, the institutional earned service from the disbursed credit will be determined for institutional purposes only. The treatment of any federal student aid funds will be determined and processed in accordance with the institutional Return of Title IV Funds policy and applicable federal regulations.
- III. If the student withdraws after completing more than 60% of the academic period, institutional charges will be assessed based on earned service. The treatment of any federal student aid funds will be determined exclusively through the institutional Return of Title IV Funds process and applicable federal regulations.
